La mixité sociale notamment pose toutes sortes de questions : dans les classes, aux enseignants pour la gestion des apprentissages, dans les établissements scolaires, aux responsables éducatifs, aux décideurs politiques pour les orientations nationales. Enfin, c'est à tout le corps social, et singulièrement aux parents d'élèves, que les choix fondamentaux reviennent.
